Lee Jay Berman became a full-time mediator 20 years ago. He has successfully mediated over 1,800 litigated matters and is on the panels of the American Arbitration Association (AAA), and the United States Bankruptcy Court. He has been named to a bevy of “Top Neutrals” lists and is a member of several other distinguished mediation organizations, including among them the International Academy Mediators and the National Academy of Distinguished Neutrals.

Also a prominent trainer in the field, Lee Jay founded the American Institute of Mediation in 2008, leaving his position as Director of Pepperdine Law School’s “*Mediating the Litigated Case*” program after 7 years. He has lectured and trained at a dozen different universities and law schools as well as for mediators, judges and business leaders across the U.S. and in India, Australia, Jordan, Croatia, Amsterdam and Dubai.
